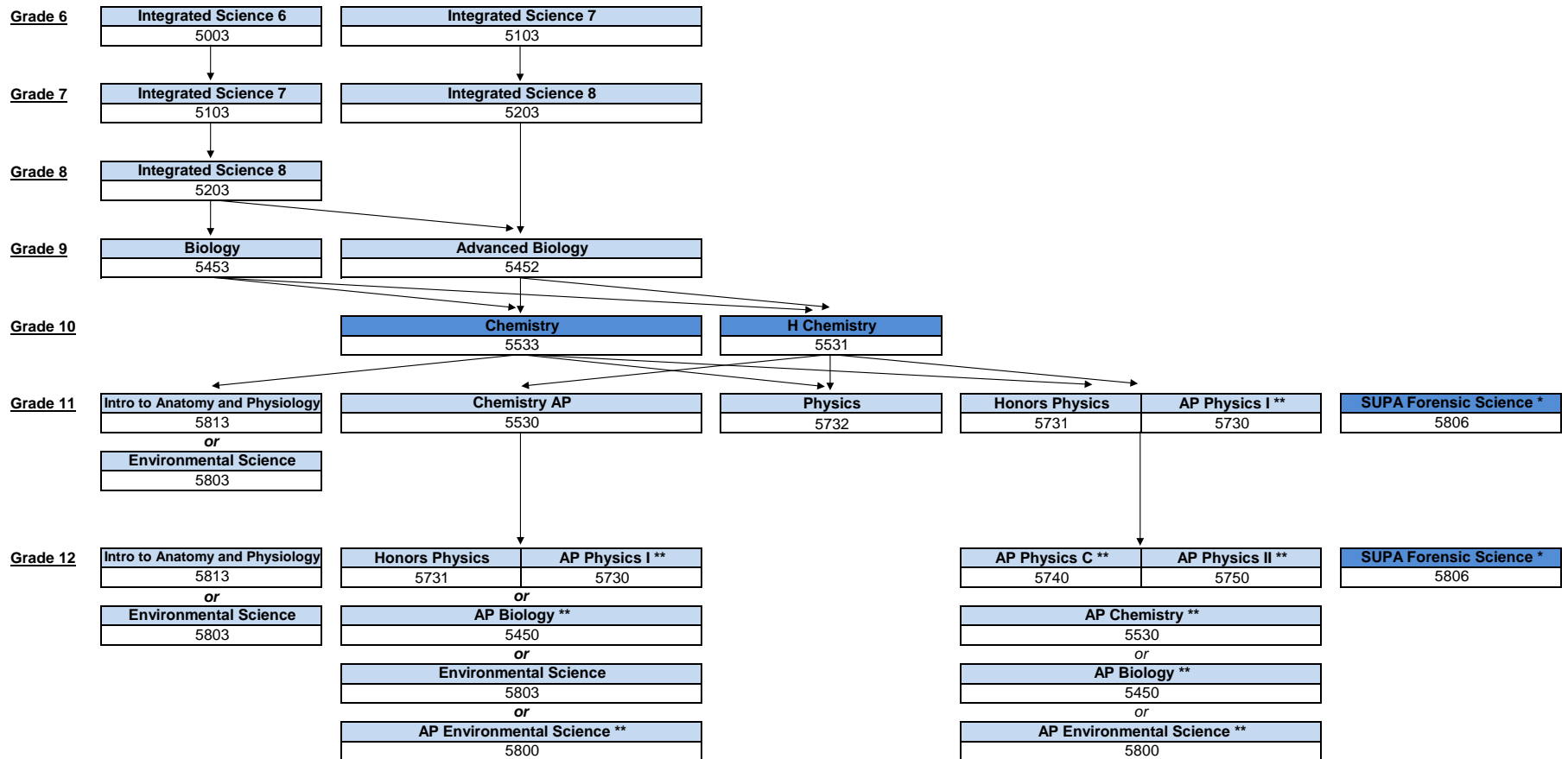
WORLD LANGUAGE
